


You are required to purchase an *iClicker* remote. *iClicker* is a response system that allows you to respond to questions I pose during class, and you will be graded on that feedback and/or participation. Each clicker has a unique serial number on the back of the remote. Place a piece of scotch tape over that bar code and ID to preserve it. In order to receive credit for your votes, you will need to register your *iClicker* remote online within the first week of class. You must have come to class at least once and voted on at least one question in order to complete this registration properly. Once you have voted on a question in my class, go to [www.iclicker.com/registration](http://www.iclicker.com/registration). The *iClicker* response system will be used every day in class, and you are responsible for bringing your remote daily and ensuring you have enough battery charge to use it effectively.

### **Purchase Your iClicker:**

1. Either from the bookstore, Amazon, or you can even borrow one for the semester.

### **Register Your iClicker:**

1. You must register your *iClicker* to receive credit. You can still use it before you register, and it will save your scores until you do.
2. Go to <http://www.iclicker.com/registration/>
3. You will need:
  - First Name (exactly as it appears in WebCampus)
  - Last Name (exactly as it appears in WebCampus)
  - Student ID (this is the ID that uses your last name, it is typically the same as your rebel mail ID, it is not your numeric NSHE ID)
  - Remote ID (the series of numbers and sometimes letters found on the bottom of the back of your *iClicker* remote, if it is worn off, you must **come in to my office** for us to look up)
4. Type in the information, click “enter” and follow the prompts
