

WEBASSIGN STUDENT GETTING STARTED GUIDE

WebAssign allows you to submit homework, quizzes, and tests completely online at any time of day or night. WebAssign is a required portion of your course and your proper usage of the program may count toward your final grade. Use this student instruction guide to help you get started!

LOGGING IN

You can log in to WebAssign using any Web browser connected to the Internet. Your professor has uploaded the class roster in WebAssign (so you do NOT need a class key). All you need to register is:

- Your WebAssign Username your rebel mail email address / web campus ID
- Your Institution or School Code UNLV
- Your Initial WebAssign Password bellomo

If you have this information open your Web browser and enter the following Web address: <http://www.webassign.net/login.html>. Enter the information above.

NOTE: **If you are unable to register**, email the professor at carryn.bellomo@unlv.edu. Sometimes there are issues with students who register late, and you must be added to the professor's roster BEFORE you can add yourself into the course. Also, if you used WebAssign before, you will not see a link in your old account. You will have to re-enroll.

ACCESS CODES

The first time you log in, you will be required to enter an Access Code from the WebAssign PassCard included with your textbook. Simply scratch off the silver coating in the middle of the card to reveal your individual access code. Your code will have 2 or 3 letters followed by 10 or 11 numbers. This number must be entered using the registration link on your class announcement page to register you with WebAssign.

If you need to purchase an access code, you may do so with a credit card when you first log in to the program. You have 14 days from the start of your course to purchase an access code, during the 14 day grace period you will be able to access WebAssign.

ANSWERING QUESTIONS

WebAssign has a variety of different question types, ranging from multiple choice to fill-in-the-blanks to symbolic questions. Here are some things to keep in mind as you work through your assignments:

- Some questions may include numbers that appear in **red**. This signifies that the number has been randomized, so that you receive a different version of the same basic question from your classmates.
- Some WebAssign questions check the number of **significant figures** in your answer. If you enter the correct value with the wrong number of significant figures, you will not receive credit, but you will receive a hint that your number does not have the correct number of significant figures.
- Some questions require entering **symbolic notation**. Answer symbolic questions by using calculator notation. You must use the exact variables specified in the questions. The order is not important as long as it is mathematically correct. Clicking on the **eye button** previews the expression you enter in proper mathematical notation. Clicking on the **symbolic formatting help button** provides tips for using the correct keystrokes.
- Some questions may require the use of an **Active Figure** simulation. Active Figures require the free Macromedia Flash Player plug-in, downloadable from www.macromedia.com.
- At any point in the assignment, you can save your work without grading by selecting the **Save Work** button at the end of the question. After you save your work, it will be available to you the next time you click the assignment.
- To submit your answer for grading, you can click the **Submit This Question Only** button at the bottom of each question. To submit the entire assignment for grading, click the **Submit All Questions for Grading** button at the end of the assignment.

TECHNICAL SUPPORT

You can visit the WebAssign Technical Support center by visiting www.webassign.net and selecting the Contact Us button on the top menu bar. Additional student support can be found when logged directly into WebAssign by clicking the Help link in the upper right corner. Here you will have access to the complete WebAssign Student Guide, be able to access frequently asked questions and contact a WebAssign support person.

If you are having difficulties, verify that you are using the most up to date browsers and plug ins, in order to ensure that their computers meet the application's [System Requirements](#). Without these plug ins, we will not be able to troubleshoot the application issues that students encounter and report them to our Development Team.
