

In order to complete the research assignment for this course, you will need to know how to find resources through the Architecture Studies Library. There are a number of modules posted on the Library web page to assist you with this. Each covers an essential component of researching and writing papers, with particular emphasis finding sources for research in design fields; many students find it beneficial to work through each of the modules. Modules 5, 10 & 12 are particularly relevant to the work you will do in this class.

**Assignment:** Module 5 Test for Scenario 2

You are to take the test at the end of this module, print it out with your answers, and turn it in at the beginning of next week's Discussion section.

**Process:**

- 1) Make sure you have a barcode on your Rebel Card, have activated the cash option, and have money in it – go to Moyer Student Union to take care of this if you haven't yet (you can also add money via credit card at the Rebel Card web page)
- 2) GO on line to UNLV Libraries Home Page. Branches are listed in red at the bottom center of the page; select "Architecture Studies."

Now you are ready to begin. Starting from the Architecture Studies Library menu screen:

- a) click on "Modules and Guides"
- b) click on Module 5 "Magazine/journal articles"
- c) work through Module 5, up to and including the Self-Test
- d) under "Test Yourself" (at the bottom of the listed entries), click on "Scenario Two"
- e) fill in your answers to the test – **USE THE NAME OF THE DESIGNER YOU ARE RESEARCHING FOR THIS CLASS AS THE KEYWORD**
- f) print the test with your answers (use "Print Preview" under the "File" drop-down menu to select just the pages you want to print, or you may print the entire module and find yourself having to pay for printing many more pages than you need)
- g) turn in a **XEROXED COPY** of the test with your answers and the print-out that you generated during the test (keep the originals as the start of your research for your project)
