Milan, IT; ca. 382; plan by St. Ambrose (then Bishop of Milan)

Notre Dame d'Amiens

Amiens, FR; begun 1220

Il Redentore

Venice; 1576-80; Palladio

Benedictine Abbey Church

Weltenburg, Germany; begun 1718; the Asam brothers
