1604-1612; patron, King Henri IV

Place Vendôme
begun 1698; Jules Hardoin-Mansart; patron, King Louis XIV

London: Covent Garden; 1630-31; Inigo Jones; patron, Earl of Bedford
- St. Paul's Covent Garden
